Since 2009, Luthercare has offered scholarships to our nursing team members who were advancing their education and professional development.

Adding to this, Luthercare recently extended the scholarship program to high school seniors embarking on careers in nursing. Because of support from people like you, Luthercare has been able to distribute \$90,000 to 70 high school seniors since 2020. Without your support, the scholarship program would not be possible. Thanks to a generous grant from LeadingAge PA, we are excited to extend the scholarship program further by introducing an eight-week paid interdisciplinary internship. The internship provides one of our recent scholarship winners with guidance and mentorship by shadowing team members, nurses, and senior leadership to develop skills and knowledge specific to nursing and administrative aspects of senior living. We are excited to welcome past scholarship recipient Allison Keeney as an intern this summer.

Allison, pictured left, graduated from Warwick High School and currently attends Lebanon Valley College, where she is pursuing her Bachelor of Science in Nursing. Allison's connection to Luthercare started with the nursing

scholarship and strengthened on a professional level with the internship. Her grandmother, Elsa, also just moved onto the Luther Acres campus. In her own words:
